F10/19	<u>DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST</u> – None.
F11/19	<u>MINUTES OF MEETING</u> On the proposition of Cllr. Hurn and seconded by Cllr. Flatt it was unanimously resolved to approve the minutes of the Finance & General Purposes Committee meeting held on 19 th February 2019 as a correct record.

F13/19	<u>PUBLIC PARTICIPATION</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cllr. Holden – agenda item 7 (Grant – Wymondham in Bloom). – concern over amount requested and what has happened to baskets previously purchased.
F14/19	<u>GRANT APPLICATION</u> After discussion upon the resolution of Cllr. Flatt and seconded by Cllr. J Hornby it was resolved to offer a grant of £750 towards the cost of a projector costing £2880.00.
F15/19	<u>GRANT APPLICATION</u> After discussion upon the resolution of Cllr. J Hornby and seconded by Cllr. Hurn it was agreed to offer a grant of £250 towards the non- floral display costs of £500 and a maximum of £1,000 towards floral display costs, providing that they are purchased from the price list provided by Wymondham Garden Centre and are supported by the appropriate documentation.
F16/19	<u>KETTS DAY</u> Cllr. Holden was invited to outline his proposal that an event be organised for 1 st September 2019. He updated his paper advising that South Norfolk Council had replaced their offer of a £500 grant with an offer to underwrite the event to the sum of £2500 to be matched by the Town Council. An organisation called Black Knight would put on displays etc for a cost of £4800 and would seek sponsorship. After a lively discussion, during which a number of primarily financial and organisational issues were raised, the Committee Chairman, Cllr. J Hornby, withdrew the item.
