LE25/19 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE – Cllr. Batchelor

LE26/19 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST – None.

LE27/19 MINUTES OF MEETING On the proposition of Cllr. Travis and seconded by Cllr. James it was resolved to approve the minutes of the Leisure and Environment Committee meeting held on 17th September 2019 as a correct record.

LE31/19 _ BUDGET 2020/21 Clerk presented the draft for discussion and submission to the Finance & General Purposes Committee for incorporation into the Council budget for the 2020/21 financial year. He explained that this might be subject to some minor amendments as the Council would not receive the final information from South Norfolk Council until early December which is required to complete the budget setting process. After discussion upon the resolution of Cllr. Roberts and seconded by Cllr. James it was unanimously resolved to recommend a budget of £181,706 to the Finance & General Purposes Committee.
