- LE01/20 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE – None
- LE02/20 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST – Cllr. Travis – Town Crier – Non - pecuniary.
- LE03/20 MINUTES OF MEETING On the proposition of Cllr. Roberts and seconded by Cllr. James it was unanimously resolved to approve the minutes of the Leisure Environment Enterprise & Tourism Committee meeting held on 19th November 2020 as a correct record.
- LE04/20 PROGRESS UPDATE
- Youth Market Email from National Market Traders Federation received advising that they will be arranging a regional event in Norwich probably in July/August 2020
 - Tolls Meadow Clerk confirmed repair work to bridges had been completed.
- LE05/20 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION
- Tony Vale – Farmers Market – Spoke in favour of publicising market and a cake for the 20th Anniversary in March 2020.
 - Cllr. Hurn commended Council having a Facebook page.
- LE06/20 FACEBOOK Paper prepared and presented with the Agenda outlining the pro's and con's of having a Facebook page was discussed. It was agreed that the Council should pursue this with it being controlled by the Clerk and office staff. It would be for publishing information and promoting events with the comment's facility switched off.

- LE08/20 CHRISTMAS TREE Discussions took place following an offer by a local company to sponsor a Christmas Tree. The need to minimize any risk to the Town Council was stated and that there needed to be a robust risk/ Health & Safety assessment, together with liability insurance, incorporated into a detailed proposal. It was agreed that Cllr. Roberts would contact the sponsor to outline the Council's thoughts and to seek their view on the possibility of lighting up the existing trees on the Fairland Green using solar

powered units.
